- Enlisted in the US Army on May 4, 1942
- Attended O.C.S. (Officer's Candidate School) at Ft. Benning, GA, October 1942- January, 1943
- Made a 2nd Lieutenant by Act of Congress, January 20, 1943
- An Officer with the 80th Infantry Training Battalion at Camp Roberts, CA, February 1943 – May 1944
- Promoted to 1st Lieutenant on December 31, 1943
- Assigned to Co. G, 395th Inf. Regt, 99th Inf. Div. at Camp Maxey, TX in June 1944
- Staged for overseas duty at Camp Myles Standish, MA September 17, 1944
- Boston Port of Embarkation on September 30, 1944
- Sailed on the troopship SS Argentina
- Arrived in England on October 9, 1944
- Landed in Le Havre, France on November 1, 1944

- Awarded the C.I.B. (Combat Infantryman's Badge) on November 24, 1944
- Awarded the Bronze Star in late January 1945 for Meritorious Service in Belgium & Germany, November 10, 1944 through January 24, 1945
- Awarded the Purple Heart for wound received in action in the Monshcau Forest, February 2, 1945
- Awarded second Bronze Star for the Battle of Kalterherberg, Germany, February 5, 1945
- Awarded the Silver Star for the Battle of Honnor, Germany, March 15, 1945
- Injured at the Remagen Bridgehead, March 17, 1945
- Awarded his second Purple Heart on April 22, 1945 while a patient at the 140th General Hospital
- V-E (Victory in Europe) Day, May 8, 1945
- Transferred to the 16th Inf. Regt., 1st Inf. Div., August 27, 1945
